University Center Hosts Training Seminar on Reporting Crime on Campus

SIOUX FALLS, SD – March 24, 2009 – University Center will host a training seminar on compliance with the Jeanne Clery Act for reporting incidences of crime on campus. Jennifer Furan, a certified Clery Act trainer, will lead the session, which will be held Friday, March 27 at 2:00 p.m. in Avera Hall on University Center's North campus.

The Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act (20 USC 1092(f)) is a landmark federal law, originally known as the Campus Security Act, that requires colleges and universities across the United States to disclose information about crime on and around their campuses.

The training session is part of an ongoing effort at University Center to ensure safety on campus and compliance with the law the in how crimes are reported. Security representatives from all area campuses are invited to attend. The session is free of charge and open to the public.

Jennifer Furan is the Security Coordinator for St. Cloud State University's Public Safety Department. She is a LEMAP (Loaned Executive Management Assistance Program) assessor and a certified trainer for the Clery Act. Furan holds a bachelor's degree in Psychology, a Master's of Science in Criminal Justice with an emphasis in Campus Law Enforcement, and an additional Master's of Science in Public Safety Executive Leadership from St. Cloud State University.
