



University Center Hosts Ribbon Cutting for Science & Technology Classroom Building

SIOUX FALLS, SD – September 8, 2011 – South Dakota Public Universities & Research Center will host a Chamber of Commerce Ribbon Cutting ceremony on Friday, September 9th at 11:30 a.m. to celebrate the opening of the new Science & Technology Classroom Building. The public is invited to attend.

The 50,000 square foot Science & Technology Classroom Building is a direct result of a partnership between the Sioux Falls School District and the South Dakota Board of Regents. The building is replacement space for the area University Center vacated on the Southeast Technical Institute campus to make way for the School District's New Technology High. The building includes 20 classrooms and more than 50 office spaces, as well as conference rooms and study spaces for student use.

The Ribbon Cutting ceremony will begin at 11:30 a.m. followed by a reception and open house, during which the public is invited to tour the building. University Center is located at the corner of 60th Street North and Career Avenue, just west of I-29 at exit 83.
